Affordable fun access program

The city of Regina offers residents a reduced cost option to assist in reducing the financial barrier many families face. Leisure Passes can be purchased for 50 per cent off the regular price and residents can participate in registered programs at 80 per cent off the regular price, to a maximum of \$160 discount per family member.
